

LIUNA LOCAL 506 TRAINING CENTRE COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY:

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

The Local 506 Training Centre's Vaccination Policy applies to all attendees of the Centre's campus and/or off-site third-party training locations effective **September 7, 2021**.

All attendees must review the full Policy and comply with its terms and also comply with all existing COVID-19 health and safety protocols in place at the Centre's campus and/or off-site third-party training locations at the time of attendance/entry.

Attendees that fail or refuse to comply with the Policy will not be permitted to attend and/or enter the Centre's campus and/or off-site third-party training locations and will also be subject to the other enforcement provisions set out in section 7 of the Policy.

Fully Vaccinated Attendees:

The *COVID-19 Vaccination Protocol* set out in section 5(i) of the Policy goes into effect on **September 7, 2021** and shall remain in place until further notice. Attendees that provide the Centre with proof of full vaccination status shall not be required to participate in any COVID-19 antigen testing at this time.

Attendees Granted a Medical and/or Human Rights Exemption:

The *COVID-19 Testing Protocol for Medical and Human Rights Exemptions* set out in section 5(ii) of the Policy goes into effect on **September 7, 2021** and shall remain in place until further notice. Attendees that are granted an exemption by the Centre must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen test result issued by a testing facility and/or service provider acceptable to the Centre (eg. Ministry of Health testing facility and/or pharmacy) that is conducted no more than forty-eight (48) hours prior to any attendance/entry and on regular forty-eight (48) hour intervals thereafter. Attendees granted an exemption must pay for the cost of testing.

Partially Vaccinated Attendees:

The *Temporary COVID-19 Testing Protocol for Partially Vaccinated Attendees* set out in section 5(iii) of the Policy goes into effect on **September 7, 2021** and shall only remain in place **until October 30, 2021**. Partially vaccinated attendees must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen test result issued by a testing facility and/or service provider acceptable to the Centre (eg. Ministry of Health testing facility and/or pharmacy) that is conducted no more than forty-eight (48) hours prior to any attendance/entry and on regular forty-eight (48) hour intervals thereafter until they reach full vaccination status. Partially vaccinated attendees must pay for the cost of testing.

Unvaccinated Attendees:

The *COVID-19 Testing Protocol for Unvaccinated Attendees* set out in section 5. (iv) of the Policy goes into effect on **September 7, 2021** and shall remain in place until further notice. Attendees that remain unvaccinated, refuse to disclose their vaccination status and/or not otherwise granted a medical and/or human rights exemption by the Centre must: 1. provide the Centre with proof of completion of the City of Toronto Public Health education session entitled "COVID-19 Vaccination: Understanding the Benefits and Risks" which can be accessed at the website: https://www.toronto.ca/ext/digital_comm/tp/covid-19-vaccination-understanding-the-benefits-and-risks/story_html5.html ; and 2. provide proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen test result issued by a testing facility and/or service provider acceptable to the Centre (eg. Ministry of Health testing facility and/or pharmacy) that is conducted no more than forty-eight (48) hours prior to any attendance/entry and on regular forty-eight (48) hour intervals thereafter. Unvaccinated attendees must pay for the cost of testing.
